## **DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES' SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

What is a DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES' Scholarship?

DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES' Scholarships provide financial assistance to high school seniors who exhibit excellence in a well-rounded educational and extracurricular program. The scholarships are made possible by the Annual DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES' MEMBERSHIP DUES, and are administered by the DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES' Scholarship Committee.

Who is eligible for a DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES' Scholarship?

Any current high school senior wrestler who is enrolled in a public or accredited private school in District 6; has attained a 2.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA) non-weighted based on a 4.0 scale for the three previous academic years. (Grades 9, 10, and 11); and are planning to continue their education beyond high school in an accredited institution of higher education or technical school.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. The DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES' Scholarship committee will consider the following for the purposes of awarding Scholarships.
  - A. Academic Achievement **25%** (G.P.A. and Class Rank)
  - B. Athletic Achievement **25%**
  - C. Essay Contest **50%**
2. May be used at any institution of recipient's choice. Education program must be designed to take one or more years to complete.
3. Recipients will be announced in May and receive a letter from the DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES. A list of all winners will be sent to their guidance counselors. Non-recipients will not be notified.
4. All winners must submit a certificate of admission or letter of acceptance to the DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES' Scholarship Committee by June 1st. No letter, No scholarship.
5. Scholarships can be used for tuition, books, laboratory fees and other academic costs; room and board when a student is housed under the control of the institution.
6. Scholarship checks are sent directly to the Financial Aid Office of the institution in the third week in August by the DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES. If the student is already receiving financial aid from the institution, a check will be sent to the individual upon receipt of receipts for

books, tuition, lodging, computer etc. The check will be sent when the receipts are received by the DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES.

7. If the recipient leaves the institution and there are DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES' scholarship funds remaining, the institution shall return the balance to the DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES.

8. If a scholarship winner must delay their education for any reason, the scholarship will be held up to 2 years from the date of high school graduation.

9. The DISTRICT VI WRESTLING COACHES will be awarding 4-\$250 scholarships based on previously stated criteria. An applicant will only be eligible for 1 scholarship.

10. All applications must be postmarked by April 30th of the year in which they awarded.
