Tickets

Admission is restricted due to the Public Health Emergency.

Each participant will have access to two admission tickets for the sessions in which they are participating. The codes for those tickets will be distributed by the district tournaments.

No other public admittance will be granted.

There will be NO onsite ticket sales!

Parking

Parking is available at the Arena VIP lot for approved staff and handicapped persons.

General parking is available at the Wayne Street lots, and at the Miller Stadium lot on Saturday, which are located adjacent to the facility. See attached maps. Parking is \$5.00. IUP also has a parking garage located within walking distance of the Arena.

Arena Statement on Covid Safety

As the Kovalchick Complex sets to reopen, the team has taken extra measures to welcome guests back to the KCAC. The team has worked closely with the Indiana County Public Health Department and industry professionals to create a detailed plan that will allow live events to take place at the facility. New policies and procedures that all guests need to be aware of are below. Signage and marked stations throughout the entire KCAC to visually remind guests of important health and safety guidelines throughout their entire journey, from the moment fans enter the venue, to the time they take their socially-distanced seats.

Additional health and safety protocols have been implemented at all events will include mask requirements, social distancing guidelines and more.

Mask Requirement: Properly worn face coverings will be required for all guest and staff at all times.

Socially Distant Seating: a carefully designed limited capacity arena seating map will ensure all guests are seated six feet apart.

Socially Distant Entry & Exit Process: In addition to social distancing, signage and arena staff will ensure that guests have a safe, socially-distanced journey from arrival, to seat, to departure, always staying six feet apart.

Reminders: Reminders to properly wash hands and to frequently use hand sanitizer will be located throughout the venue.

Increased Sanitization Efforts: staff will continuously wipe down touchpoints and clean surfaces throughout the event.

Increased Hand Sanitization Stations have been located around the venue.

Experiencing Symptoms: If guests are experiencing any flu or cold like symptoms, we ask them to stay home

Media

Media passes will be granted to persons with legitimate press credentials, as there is availability.

Outside Food and Drink

This year, IUP is graciously allowing outside food and drink, with the following restrictions: No coolers, No crockpots, No large tote bags or backpacks, no outside order deliveries to the Arena. Coaches may bring drinks and snacks for wrestlers.

Registration

All coaches, contestants and media will need to register and obtain their pass prior to entering the arena.

Registration will occur before Session 1 and Session 2 for Coaches and Wrestlers. Coaches will need to pick up the pack of passes for their school at the registration table. Only coaches with passes and competing wrestlers for that session will be admitted to the arena for weigh-ins. No additional wrestlers, trainers or managers will be admitted. No other persons may be present in the lobby. Coaches will need to present their Covid-19 screening form and Covid-19 Face Covering Certification at registration. **All persons** must be masked from the time they enter the arena until they leave, except those who have a mask waiver for competition. Wrestler will be stamped for admission, and should be prepared for weigh-ins and competition. There will not be locker room facilities available.

Media may register at any time during the day and will be given an all day media pass. Media passes should be requested prior to the event by sending an email to srcreps.swreg@gmail.com. Media passes are restricted in number.

No unregistered or unticketed persons will be admitted to the arena.

Coaches

Admittance for coaches will be limited for each session. Each participating school will receive 2 passes for each session in which they have a wrestler competing. We may be able to grant additional coaches passes if there are multiple wrestlers competing. This will be determined after the brackets have been set and it is determined if there are available coaches allocations. An email will be sent to the District coordinators on Monday, February 21, notifying them of schools who will receive additional coaches passes.

Coaches are required to present the COVID-19 Screening form signed by the school principal, AD, or Athletic Trainer, and the Universal Face Covering Certification, signed by the principal or AD, at the time of registration. See Attached forms.

Contestants

Admittance for contestants will be limited. Contestants will only be admitted to the sessions in which they are competing.

Due to the Public Health Emergency there will **not** be locker room facilities available for the tournament. Contestants should report to their session in uniform and ready for competition.

Contestants for each session cannot be admitted until the arena has been cleared from the previous session.

Schools must certify that contestants and coaches have not had Covid Symptoms in the past 10 days. Schools must complete the attached sheet for COVID symptoms and mask waivers and present it at registration. See Attached forms.

Advancement and Awards

The top 5 place winners will advance to the West AA Super Region Tournament on Saturday, March 6, 2021 at the Kovalchick Complex.

There will be awards for the top 6 place-winners to be presented during the finals. The awards will be presented by coaches after completion of the following weight matches in the finals.

Seeding

Six brackets will be used for the tournament. The bracket for each weight will be determined by seeding the 3 district champions. The district champions will be seeded on a point system based on last year's placement in the state tournament, and this year's record. Competition points will not be used this year, so there will be **no seeding forms**. Head to Head results may be used to override criteria in some circumstances. Final decisions on seeding will be made by the tournament director in consultation with the district coordinators.
